Family Camp Programming

Family Camp is a condensed version of our regular camp, and you can expect to enjoy all of our regular activities as part of the schedule (with some modifications):

Families get to participate in **skills** together - kayaking, canoeing, crafts, archery, outdoor survival, music will all be happening. Maybe your long time camper will lead you in a canoeing adventure up the creek or teach you how to shoot a bow! Unlike regular camp, you'll be signing up for skills *at camp*, so don't be worried if you don't see it on the registration form.

Chapel time will alternate between sessions for parents and kids to participate in together, and sessions where kids and parents have their own speakers/activities. Babysitting for toddlers will be available upon request.

Tuck and Swim is a camp must-have, and as per usual, tuck money is included in the cost of the weekend. Swimming is always a highlight on hot summer days, and it will be twice as fun with the whole family!

We often pack a lot into a single day of camp, but don't worry, there's always some **free time** to sit down and relax, or find more games to play. The play structure, torpedo ball tables, soccer fields, and volleyball court are all options, as well as our trails in the bush. **Siesta/nap time** will also be on the schedule, although if anyone in your cabin isn't ready to hold still, there will be optional activities running at the same time.

Food

We serve snack in the afternoon (Tuck) and after chapel, as well as meals. If your children need food outside of those times, feel free to bring snacks with you. If you have any dietary restrictions, let us know, and our cook team will work with you on making sure that you have the food you need. Although we take some efforts to reduce the presence of nuts on site, please note that we are not officially a nut-free facility.

Packing Recommendations

Please make sure to bring:

- water bottles
- sun protection: sunscreen, hats, sunglasses
- bug spray
- swimsuits and towels
- bedding: blankets and sheets, sleeping bags, pillows, anything else you need
- Bible and notebook for sessions
- closed-toed shoes (some of our skills require these for safety reasons)
- all the clothes/toiletries that your family needs for the weekend

Accommodation Options

We have a number of housing options to offer for family camp weekend and we hope one of them works for you!

We have 11 cabins which are stand-alone one-room dwellings with electrical outlets. The fourplex and duplex are side-by-side rooms (with walls between) also with outlets. There are central washrooms in the main lodge and outhouses on both sides of camp. There are parking spots with space to park an RV and grass spaces for tenting. Note that there are no water hook-ups for RV's and limited electrical hook-ups. Our online registration will ask you for your first and second choices from the following list. We will do our best to accommodate you!

Cabin - 4 single bunkbeds (sleeps 8)

Cabin - 5 single bunkbeds (sleeps 10)

Duplex/Fourplex - double bed and 3 single bunks (sleeps 5)

Bring your own RV

Bring your own tent

If you want to share a cabin with another family who is registered for the weekend, feel free to express that desire in the comment section of the registration form. If both families request each other we will do our best to accommodate.

Electronics Policy

One of the things we value about camp is the ability to set aside phones/ipods/video games to focus on the people around us. We ask that you partner with us in keeping distractions out of camp programming, and keep any devices you bring with you inside your cabins or leave them in your vehicle/at home for the weekend.

Privacy Policy

Just like our regular weeks of summer camp, we respect our campers right to opt out of appearing in our photographs/online media. In order to respect the privacy of those who don't wish to have their image shared,

we ask that you refrain from taking pictures at camp. We will have a camp photographer on hand, and we'll gladly send you any pictures of your family that are taken throughout the weekend.
